

Is your mobility aid bus-friendly?



You're probably already aware that London's buses are fully accessible to wheelchair users.

Did you know many other mobility aids – scooters, adapted buggies, walkers and shopping trolleys – can also board buses via the ramp.



To board the ramp and be positioned safely on London's buses your mobility aid will need to fit within the following dimensions:

Maximum width	600mm
Maximum length	1,000mm
Maximum turning radius	1,200mm

How we're supporting independent travel

If your mobility aid fits the criteria above, why not join our Mobility Aid Recognition Scheme (MARS). You'll receive a card confirming your mobility aid is bus-friendly that you can show drivers when boarding a bus.
